

Respite Quarters Companion/Sitter Volunteer Duties

The Community Crossroads Center Respite Quarters Companion/Sitter is a volunteer from the community that will monitor the behavior and well-being of Center residents. This allows homeless individuals the opportunity to rest and heal in a safe environment.

The Community Crossroads Respite Quarters Companion/Sitter will undergo some job training to ensure he or she is prepared for the daily duties as well as for any emergency situations that may arise throughout the course of the day.

Duties might include:

- Providing assistance at meal time or snack time
- Participating in planned activities
- Informally checks on resident's safety
- Providing one-on-one companionship for residents needing extra attention
- Providing status updates and reports regarding the resident to a designated member of the Shelter staff.

General Purpose Requirements/Skills:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Complies with basic Infection Control, Standard Precautions and OSHA standards
- Ability to work effectively within role independently and with other team members
- Ability to read, write and effectively communicate in English

Health Requirements:

- In good health and able to work without restrictions
